On January 1, 2010, Arenac, Huron, Sanilac and Tuscola Central Labor Councils were merged into the Bay County AFL-CIO Central Labor Council. The National AFL-CIO approved the merger and issued a new Charter for those jurisdictions: The name of the new CLC is:

Greater Bay Area Central Labor Council.

The merger was proposed by the Michigan State AFL-CIO early in 2009 as a means to increase the effectiveness of the Central Labor Council, and the effectiveness of community services in those communities.
